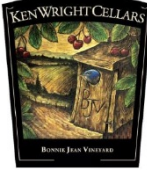

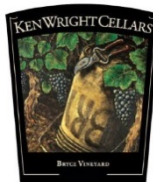

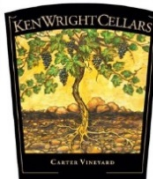

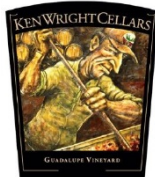
ARTWORK SHOWING THE PRACTICE OF RACKING WITH INERT GAS.

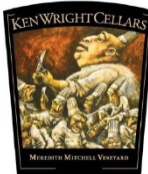

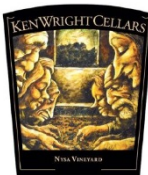

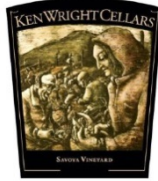
ARTWORK DEPICTS THE CRITICAL STEP OF FRUIT SORTING.

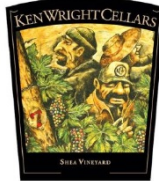
